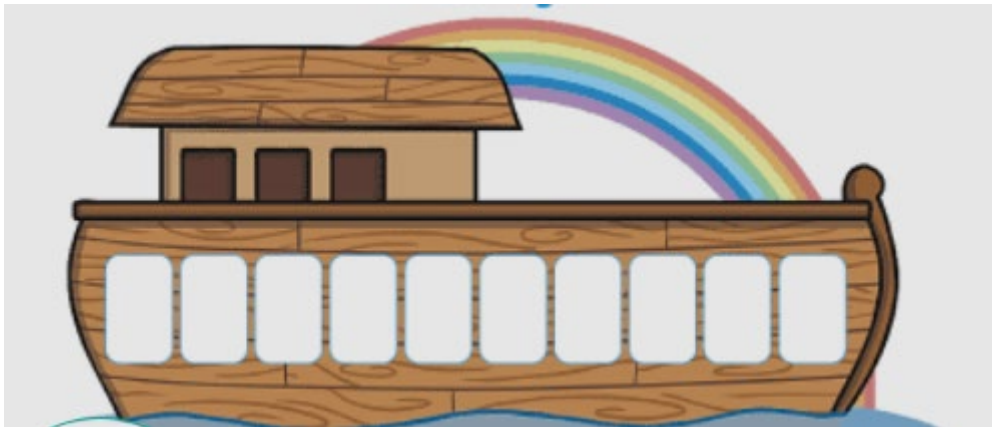


EYFS & KS1 Flood Day Activities

Maths...

The animals went in two by two:

- Counting in 2's
- Find pairs of things around your environment

English...

- Write a story about the feelings of some of the animals, when they are having to leave their homes.
- Can you create an acrostic poem about floods?

Art/DT...

- Design and make your own ark using junk model materials you can find in your home.
- Paint a rainbow picture using natural materials.

Science...

- Create a weather station to collect water, compare and record this over a period of time.
- Research what plants could grow in wet, moist growing conditions.

Physical...

- Puddling jumping (can you count in 2's as you jump in using both feet?)
- Make an inside den to represent the inside of the ark, climb and clamber inside and out of this.
