We believe that the things children learn in their early years can create lasting foundations. I believe children learn by exploring and investigating, watching and listening, talking and discussing, creating and communicating. 

Our experienced Early years team ensure that there are always lots of new and exciting play opportunities and activities set up for children. We believe that children learn best when free to explore and lead by their own interests. Children here are gently encouraged and supported but very much lead their own journey. The children are taught to believe in themselves, become independent and develop a positive attitude towards themselves, their peers and the world around us.

Play will form a large part of their day and children learn how to be creative and independent but also how to share and co-operate with each other. We encourage them to take part in small group and whole class activities so that they develop team work and social skills, while exploring reading, writing/mark making and early maths with counting and number games, shape sorting and pattern work. We also focus on emotional wellbeing so that the children learn about feelings and emotions through stories, circle time and time with their 'key worker'.

Our partnership with you, as parents, is vitally important to ensure we know your child as well as we possibly can. We actively involve parents and carers closely in the child's learning process and developmental journey using Famly to share observations, updates, information, photos and messages. We also have an open door policy and value conversations with parents concerning their child's care and education.
