Uniform & Equipment Policy

Background

In line with the DfE guidance, our uniform policy is in place to ensure all children have a sense of belonging, there is a pride in our setting, and the ethos of the school is promoted. We have ensured that uniform is suitable and safe for pupils who walk or cycle to school and actively promote the wearing of additional items such as coats and hats to stay safe. We have chosen a PE kit which is practical, comfortable and appropriate to the activities involved. We will take a sensible approach to allow for exceptions to be made during extreme weather.

Parents should not have worry about the cost of uniform and so we ensure that our uniform is affordable and have kept branded items to a minimum. We will ensure that our uniform supplier give the highest priority to cost and value for money (including the quality and durability of items) and work with them regularly to review items and orders.

School Uniform

- Blue polo shirt
- Grey trousers (not cropped trousers or leggings), tailored shorts, skirt or pinafore
- Blue check gingham dress
- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan
- Black, grey or navy socks or tights (<u>not white</u>)
- Black shoes (not trainers or high boots)

Please ensure children have a coat in school as much as possible, we still go outside for break and lunchtime in light / moderate rain.

Long hair should be tied back for school with a blue or black hairband.

A book bag is also highly recommended to allow items to be transported to and from school safely.

<u>Children do not require a back-pack</u> as there is limited cloakroom space. There is separate lunchbox storage.

PE Kit

- Navy shorts
- Blue T-shirt
- Trainers (not daps please)
- Plain navy tracksuit bottoms
- Lightweight showerproof coat (no large logos or team kits)
- Spare Socks

Children should have their PE kit in school every day.

Please make sure that all items are labelled clearly and are placed in a named, draw-string bag.

In Year 5 and Year 6, children will need a swimming costume or trunks.

Please note that bikinis and long Bermuda shorts are not suitable for school swimming.

Art aprons are provided for younger children but key stage two children may be asked to provide an apron or old shirt to wear for art/craft activities.

Nursery

We would recommend our Nursery children have a book bag to help them carry all their art work home. Our Nursery children can also purchase a school polo shirt and jumper or cardigan should they wish to.

After School Sports Clubs

Normal school PE kit should be worn. It may be advisable to have a second set of PE clothing available especially in the winter when kit may become muddy and wet. For children playing football or rugby, Astroturf shoes or studded boots are allowed.

Other Recommended Items

- Royal blue sun hat (available from our uniform supplier)
- Blue woolly winter hat (available from our uniform supplier)
- Wellies (essential in EYFS)
- Named water bottle
- Warm (waterproof) coat, preferably with a hood

Lost Property

All items of clothing should be clearly marked with the child's name.

Please check regularly to ensure that the name has not faded. Unclaimed items are deposited in the Lost Property box in the office for a reasonable period of time.

Jewellery

Only watches (no Smart Watches) and studded earrings are to be worn. All jewellery, including earrings, MUST be removed for PE.

Non Uniform Days

These are great opportunities for children to express themselves but we ask that safety and practicality is still considered please when planning an outfit. Sensible clothing and shoes are required, no sandals or flip-flops and the usual rules on jewellery still apply.

Items Not Permitted

- Any form of bracelet(s)
- Any necklace(s)
- Brightly coloured dyed hair
- · Painted finger or toenails
- False fingernails
- Pencil cases
- Personal / valuable items
- Mobile phones or other electronic items

Purchasing

Our uniform is produced by an external company and orders are placed directly through them. Items can be paid for online and either posted or collected from their local shop.
